This Indenture made this 13th day of March 1841 between John W. Carney of the one part & Jacob Sheets of the other part Both of Hardin County & State of Kentucky Witnesseth that whereas the said Carney stands justly indebted to the said Sheets in the following sums to wit One Note of hand dated 13th of November 1837 due three months after date for the sum of forty eight Dollars & fifty Cents, One note dated 24th July 1840 due one day after date for forty eight Dollars & fifty Cents One ^{note} dated 22nd September 1840 due one day after date for Twenty five Dollars & ^{twenty} ~~twenty~~ & one note dated 2nd February 1841 due one day after date for thirty five Dollars - And the said Carney wishing to secure the said Sheets in the payment thereof hath this day granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth grant bargain sell & mortgage to the said Sheets his heirs & the following articles of property to wit Eight head of Cattle 10 Head of Sheep 16 head of Hogs One Chest of Carpenters Tools, One Cloth Dress One Bureau One Chest, One Bed Two Bedsteads Two Tables, all my Cooking utensils Eight Chains, & one Clock, to him his heirs &c to have and to hold the same to the said Sheets his heirs &c - Let upon this Condition that if the said Carney shall within two years from this date well & truly pay off & discharge the debts aforesaid then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force and virtue in Law, In Witness Whereof the said Carney
